
UC Santa Cruz Latin American & Latino Studies/Sociology Combined BA Degree Curriculum Chart 2016-2017

The combined major in Sociology and Latin American and Latino Studies is an interdisciplinary course of study addressing the changing political, social, economic and cultural realities transforming both Latin America and Latina/o communities. Students are required to take a total of 12 courses (three prescribed lower-division courses, five prescribed upper-division core courses, and four upper-division electives). In addition, they must satisfy the LALS breadth and comprehensive requirements.

1. LALS Senior Seminar Course: One course in the LALS 194 Series.

 Complete a Senior Thesis. Students must enroll in 10-15 units (SOCY 195A and B mandatory, 195C is optional) of independent study thesis coursework. Students must have a faculty sponsor in both departments, and meet both department requirements.
