ONE LOWER-DIVISION COURSE FOR DECLARATION

SOCY 30A (Fall, PE-T GE) Intro to Global Information and Social Enterprise Studies

Students must complete SOCY 30A with a grade of C or better and receive approval from the Program Director in order to declare the minor. Approval takes place in SOCY 30A. Students must already be declared in a major prior to declaring a minor.

TWO UPPER-DIVISION GISES CORE COURSES

The following courses should be completed in Winter and Spring immediately after SOCY 30A

SOCY 107A (Winter) Designing ICT Projects for Social Enterprises

SOCY 107B (Spring, 3 units) Project Implementation and Grant Writing
