ONE LOWER-DIVISION COURSE FOR DECLARATION

SOCY 30A (Fall, PE-T GE) Intro to Global Information and Social Enterprise Studies

Students must complete SOCY 30A with a grade of C or better and receive approval from the Program Director in order to declare the minor. The approval process takes place near the end of SOCY 30A, and approved students will be given a permission code to enroll into SOCY 107A for Winter. Students must already be declared in a major prior to declaring a minor.
