

Meals on Wheels Application Checklist

The Meals on Wheels internship program, in collaboration with the Sociology department at UCSC, will be affording student interns an opportunity to assist Meals on Wheels with required program activities while providing students meaningful contact with the elderly community in Santa Cruz County. Student interns will be engaging in activities that provide opportunities to directly observe the challenges and issues of aging in our society.

Eligibility:

- Must be in good academic standing
- Must be a Junior or Senior standing student
- Have an interest in working with the elderly community, health care, food, or social work
- Own or have regular access to a car
- Have valid CA driver's license and car insurance
- Must be comfortable driving to different locations in Santa Cruz County, such as Ben Lomond, Live Oak, etc.

Responsibilities:

- Time commitment: about 6 hours per week.
- Make 4 home visits per week. Or work in the dining center, at Loudon Nelson Center, for two lunches per week.
- Check in with the Meals on Wheels manager regularly.
- Complete the academic portion of the 2-unit internship: meet with the faculty advisor regularly and complete assignments.
